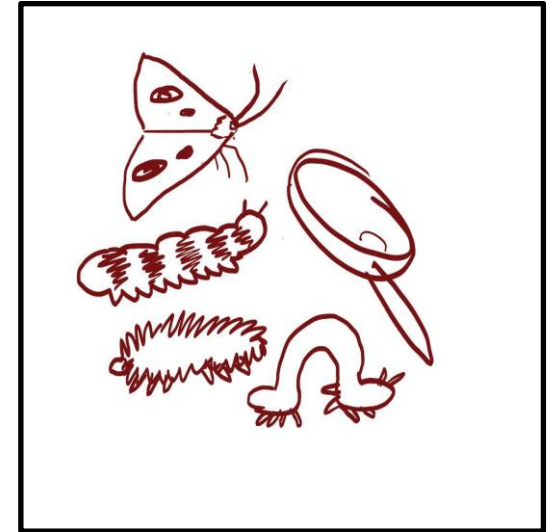
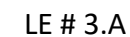


LE 3.A Taking A Focused Walk Together: Species, Kinds and Behaviors
